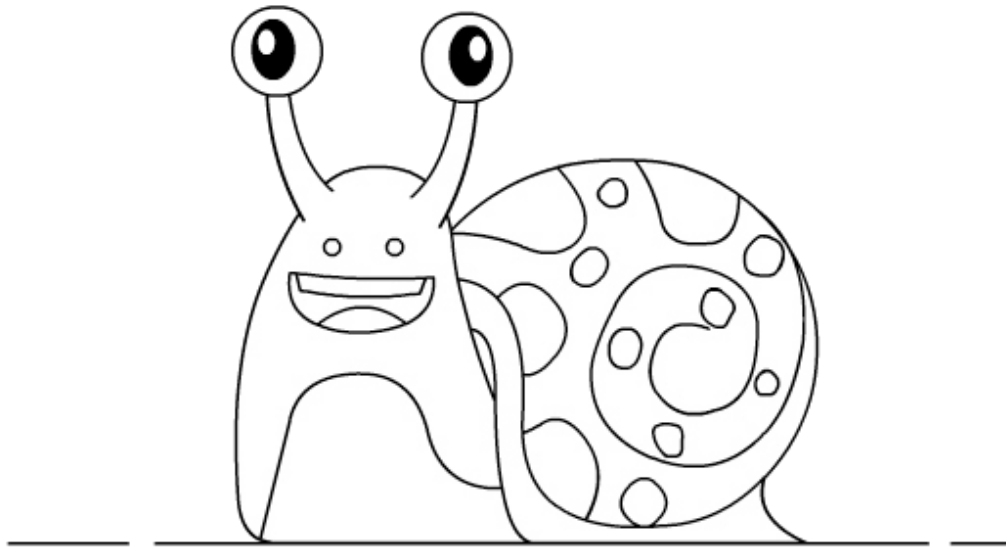


Mom can paint. Mom sets up the paints and a pail of water. "Do you want to paint?" she asks. "Yes," I say.
