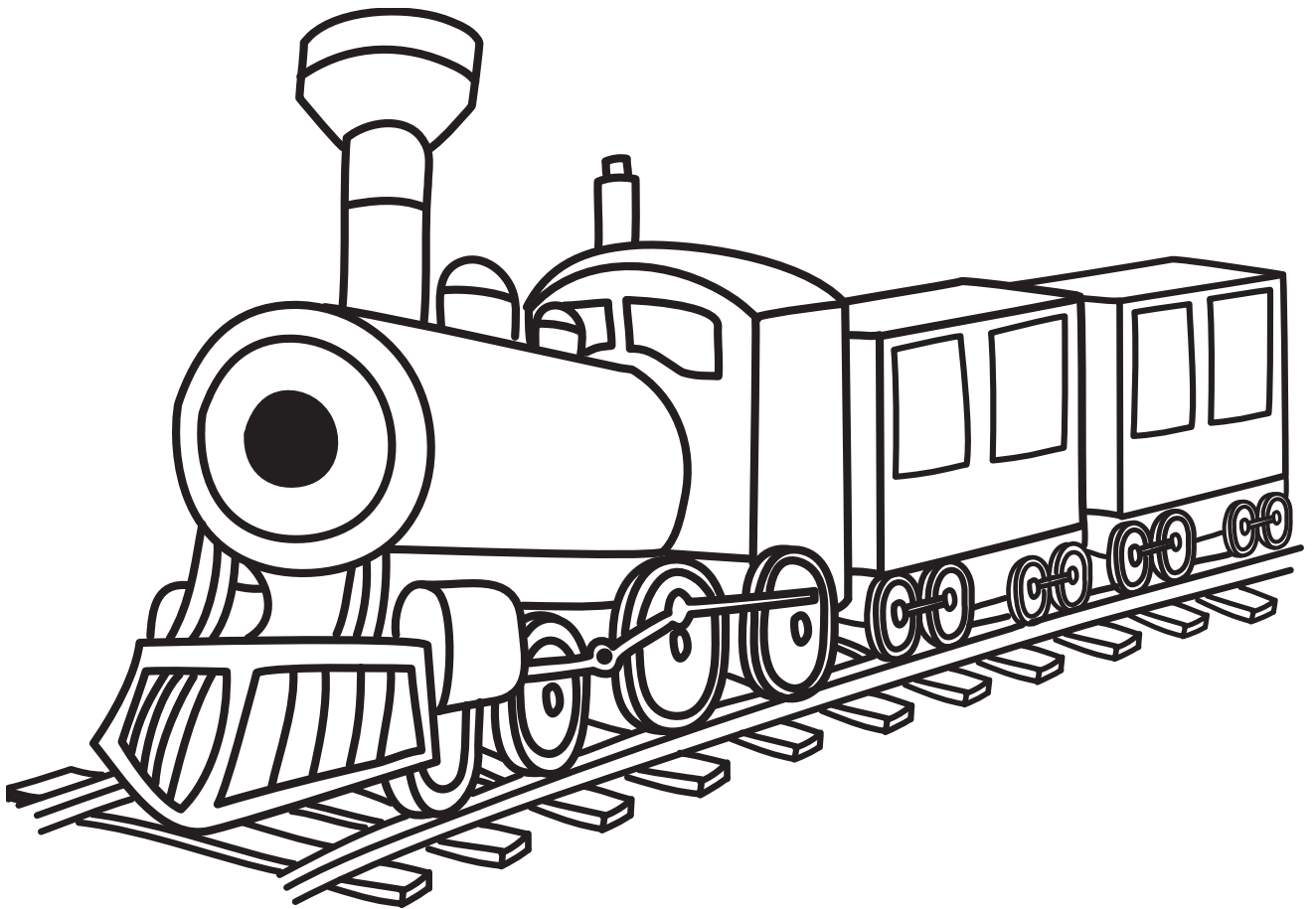


The Train Ride

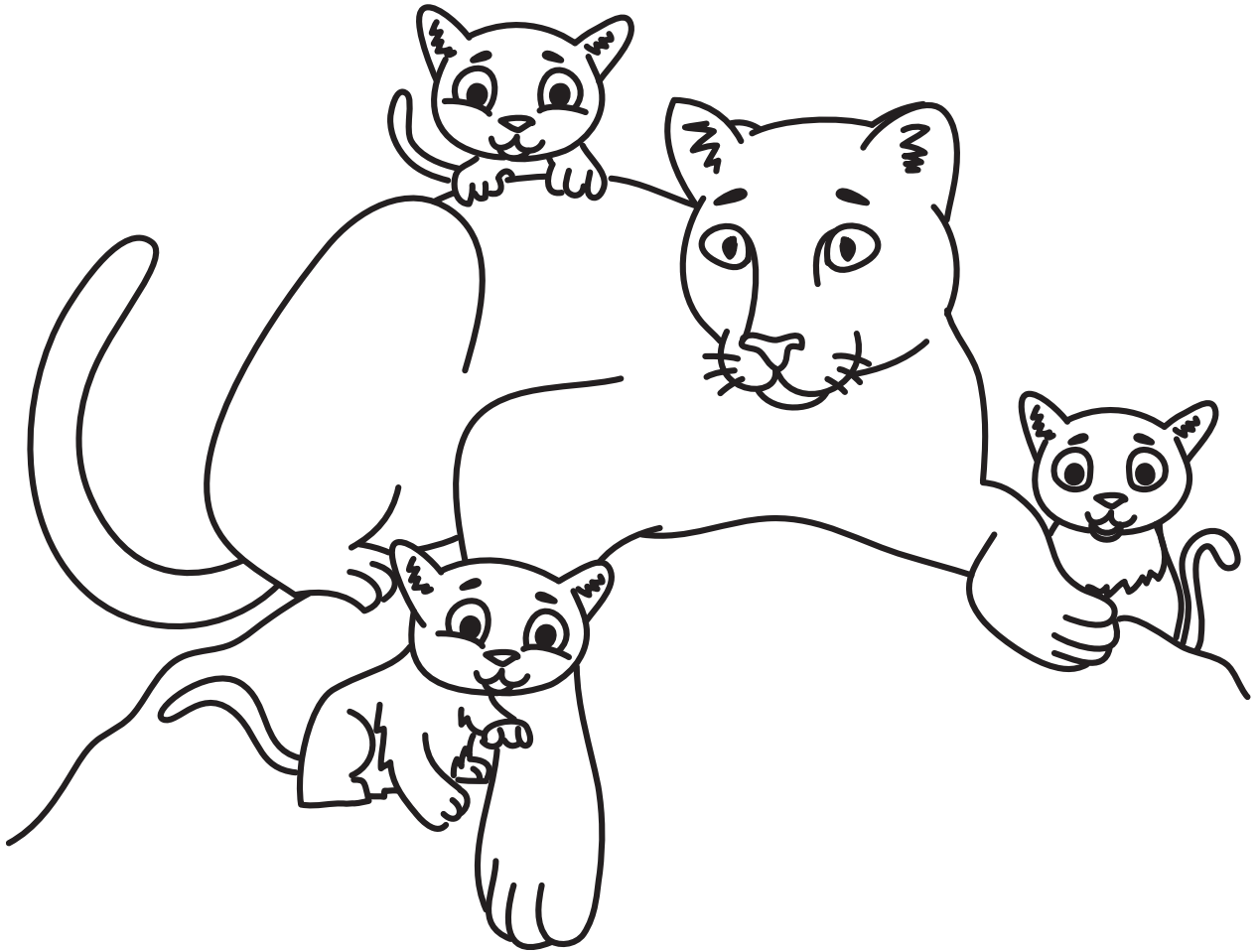
