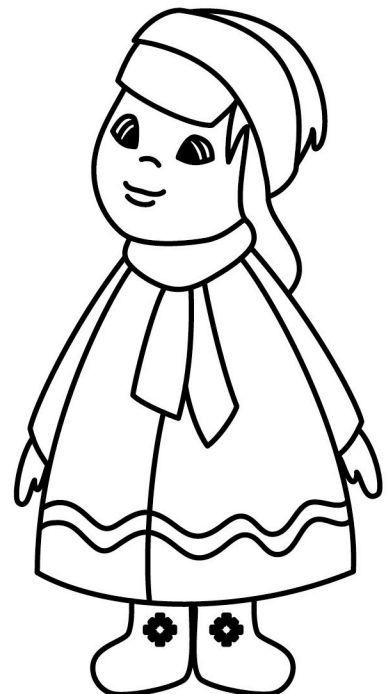

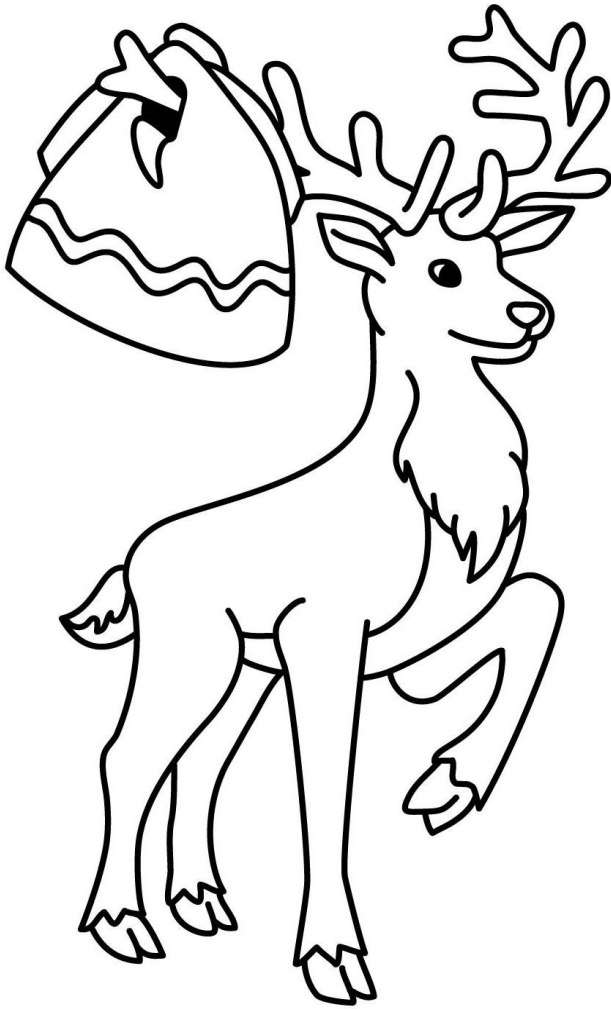
Snow fell on the hills. "You have grown," said Gram. "You need a big coat. I will make you one." Gram made a red coat.
